

2010 FOOTBALL INFORMATION

To register, you will need to have a PAYS card and a completed registration card

– if not, you will not be allowed to register.

Registration is taken on a 1st come – 1st serve basis.

“How to” Obtain a PAYS Card

The Greensboro Parks & Recreation Department requires each family (a parent), who has a player/child age 14 and under to register as a member of the national PAYS (Parents Association for Youth Sports) program before a player can participate in events hosted by Greensboro Parks & Recreation.

A parent (including coaches who are parents of players) is required to view a 19 minute video, register their family, sign parents’ code of ethics form and pay the \$5.00 fee (must have correct amount via cash, check or money order).

This video can be seen on Cable Channel 13. If viewing the video on Cable Channel 13, be sure to note the day/date and get the code at the end of the video which you will need when you register for PAYS at our office (501 Yanceyville St., M-F, 8-4:30 pm). Cable Channel 13 PAYS typical viewing schedule (approximately 20 minutes).

Parents may register for the PAYS program and the Parks & Recreation Admin Office located at 501 Yanceyville Street, 8:30 am-4:30 pm, Monday-Friday. The membership is good for five (5) years, once registered, the parent(s) will receive a card-size membership card. If your information is in the database, a lost card can be replaced for a \$1.00 fee. If it is not, the parent(s) must restart the entire PAYS process. **OUR OFFICES ARE CLOSED ON WEEKENDS!**

You can also register for PAYS online – www.nays.org (Nat’l Association of Youth Sports). Credit card is required – fee is \$6.00. Click on the green PAYS logo in left hand corner. PAYS logo rotates w/other logos in NAYS program. Click on new user (or returning user if you already have a PAYS card). Check all disclaimer boxes, click “I accept.” Click on “select a chapter.” Scroll down to “NC-Greensboro Parks & Rec.” and select. Enter code – 1141 then go from there. Print multiple copies or make copies of the original print-out of membership card for future user. If you experience problems registering, please call 800-688-KIDS!

NOTE: If you are issued a card via nays.org, please keep this card. If the card is lost, you will have to complete the entire process again. We will not have your on-line information in our City of Greensboro database.

Registration is considered incomplete if the steps outlines are omitted.
